Having been 25
Miles from home several weeks,
your last letter has not been
answered. We are in usual
health. Have had a backward
spring, but crops are now
growing finely. The Indian
difficulty is over, so that people
are comparatively safe again.

I attended a quarterly meeting
10 miles from home out on the
Prairie, in the new settlement.
over 40 were at the Communion
table. So you see there are some
Church members, in this new locality.

Wheat is now selling at 50
cents per Bushel, but the Mills are
so far off & they take so much
toll that it makes flour about 4.00
per 100 lbs. Common Labor \$1.25
per day. There are a quite a

the Country this season.
The Government land is pretty
well taken up now. Near
here.

I had 20 miles
to go to Court as Jurors.
No case for trial. Which
indicates an orderly set of
people in this County.
